



# Homeless to Homes Graphical Data Analysis

This document is a collection of the charts and data used by the Cincinnati/Hamilton County Continuum of Care for the Homeless in their Homeless to Homes plan, completed in April 2009. The document provides a graphical analysis of single homeless men and women in Cincinnati and Hamilton County, Ohio. It includes only data on singles above the age of eighteen, and provides information on men only, women only, and men and women together. The report emphasizes the differences between chronically and non-chronically homeless individuals as well as the effect of special needs on the length of stay on individuals. 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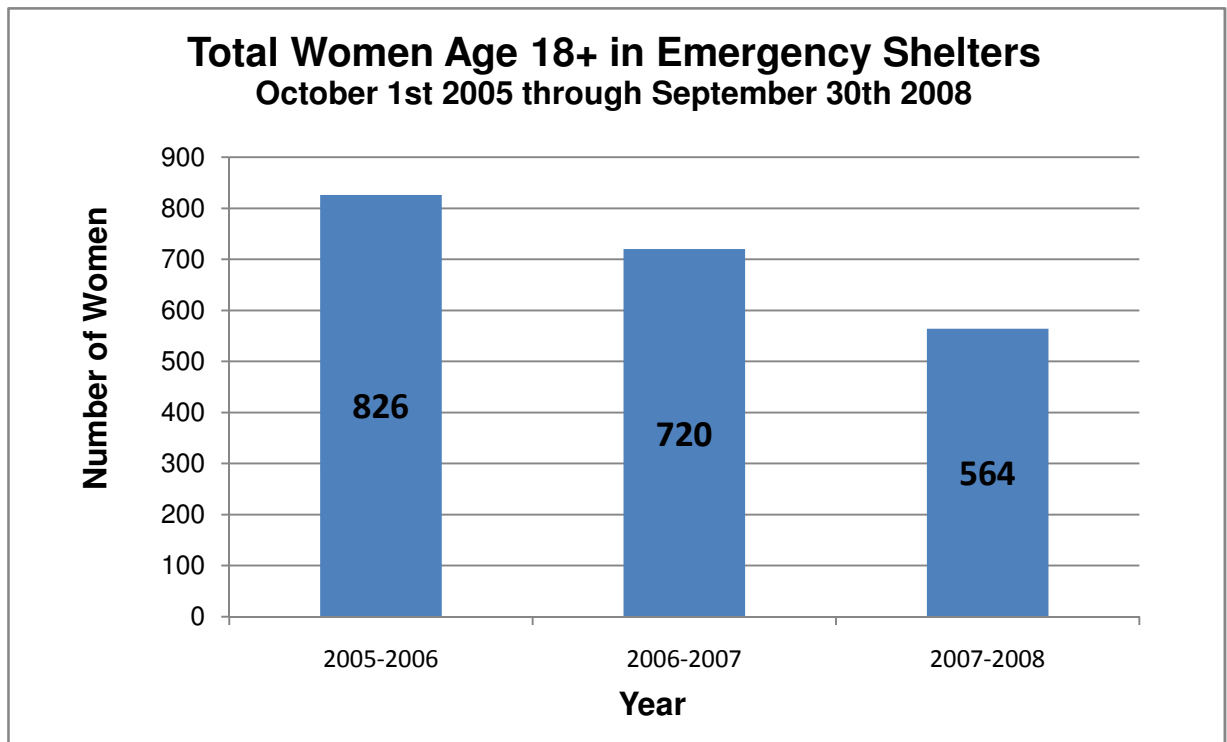

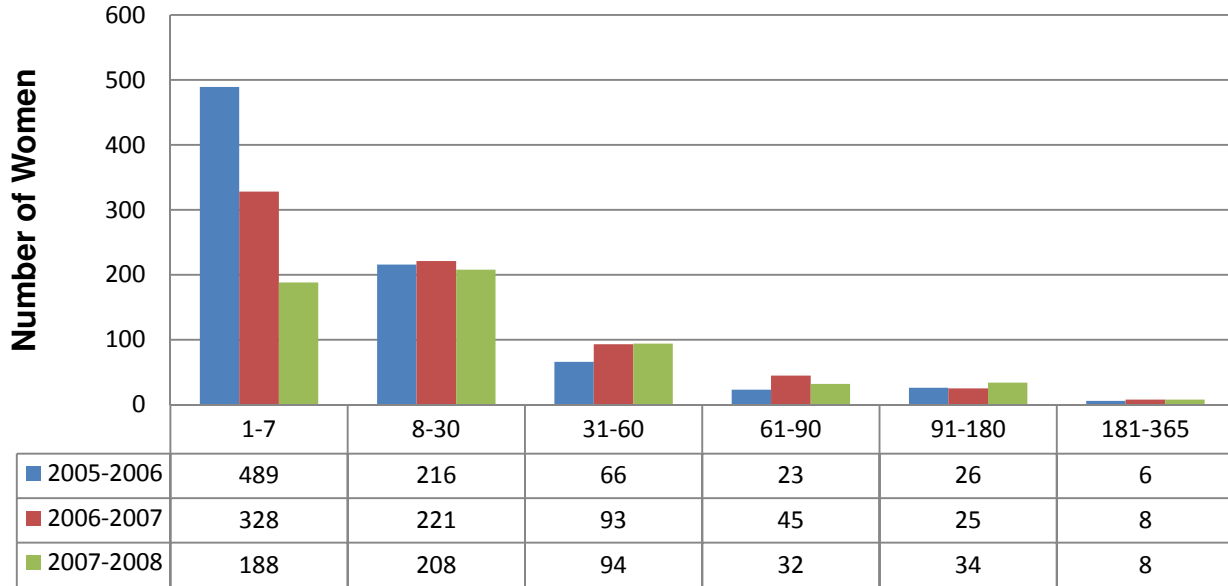

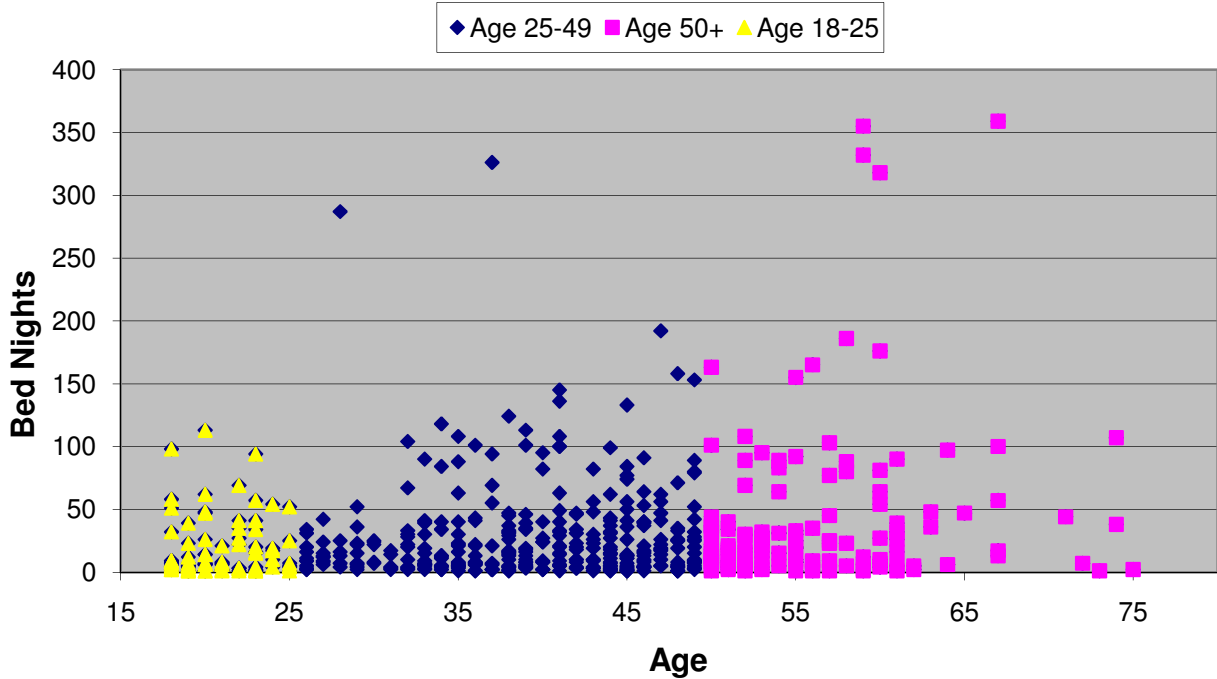


### Number of Nights Spent in Emergency Shelter, Women, Ages 18+ October 1st 2005 through September 30th 2008



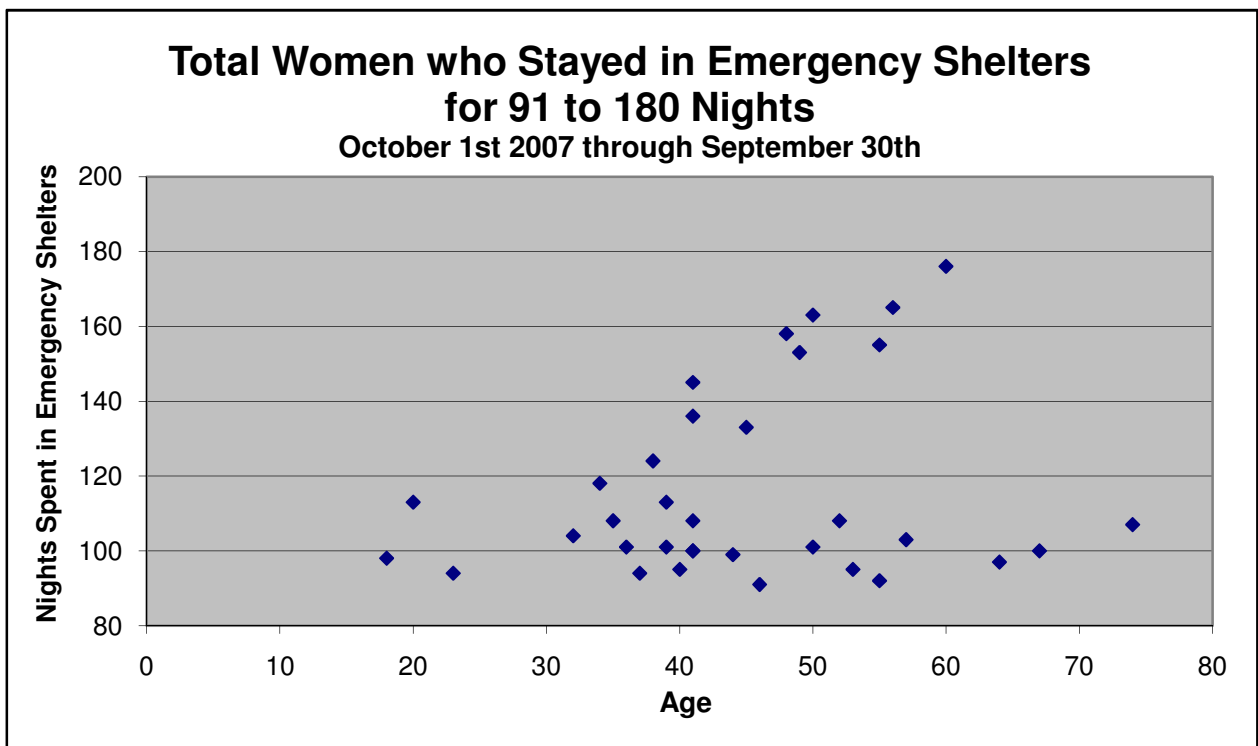
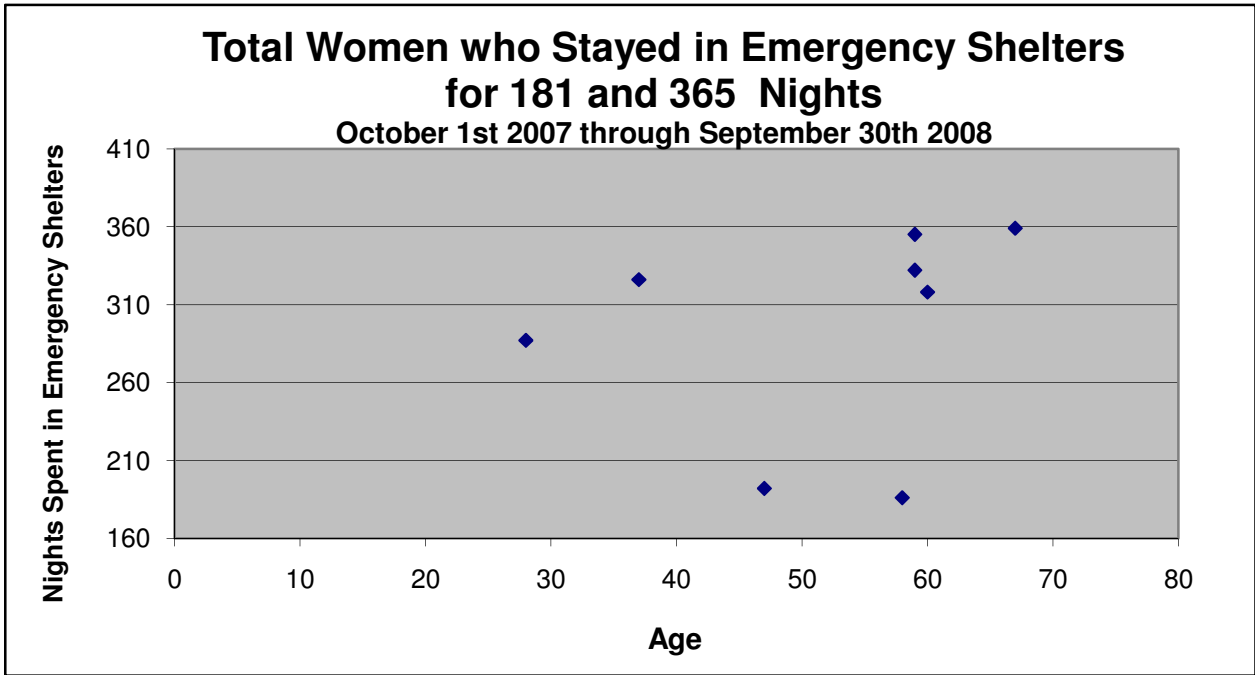
### Number of Nights Spent in Emergency Shelters by Age

October 1st 2007 through September 30th 2008



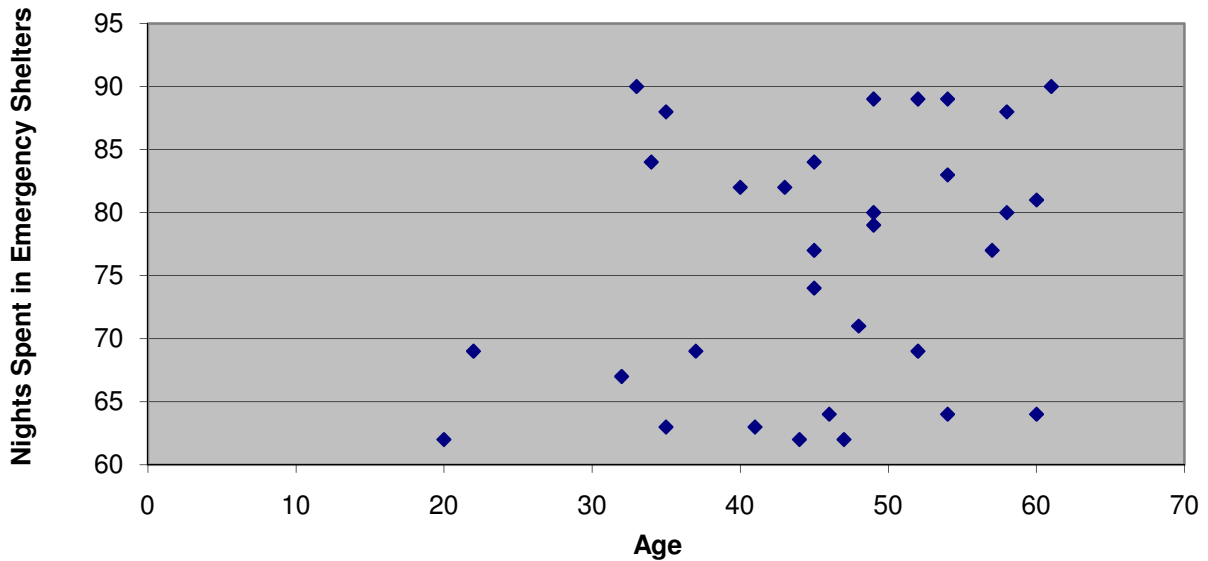
## Comparison by Number of Nights

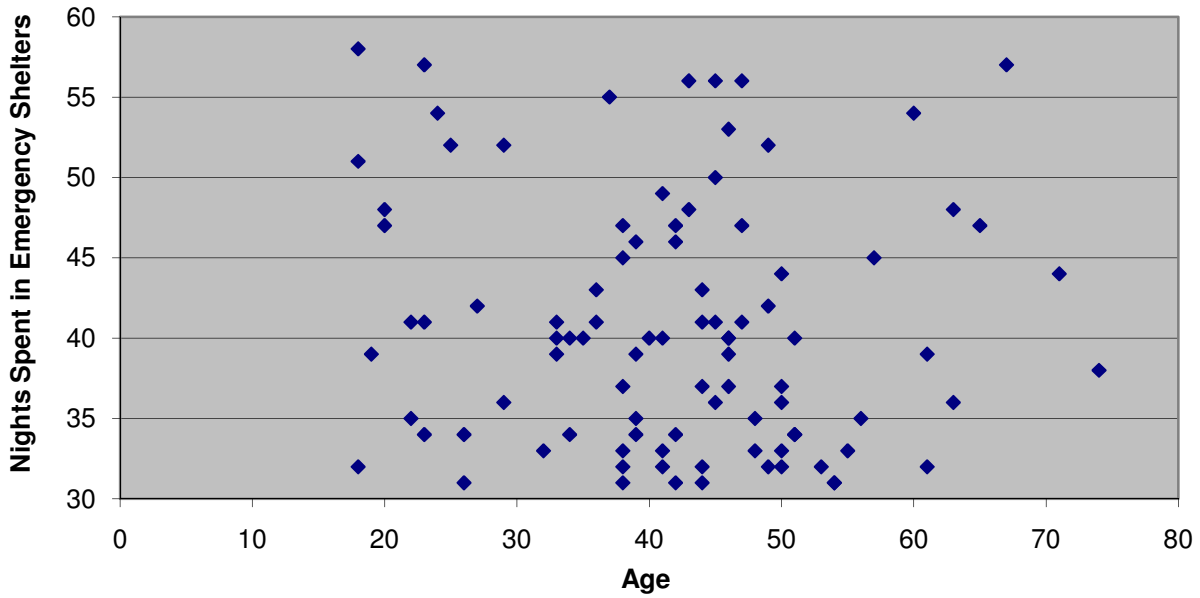
## Total Women who Stayed in Emergency Shelters for 61 to 90 Nights

October 1st 2007 through September 30th 2008



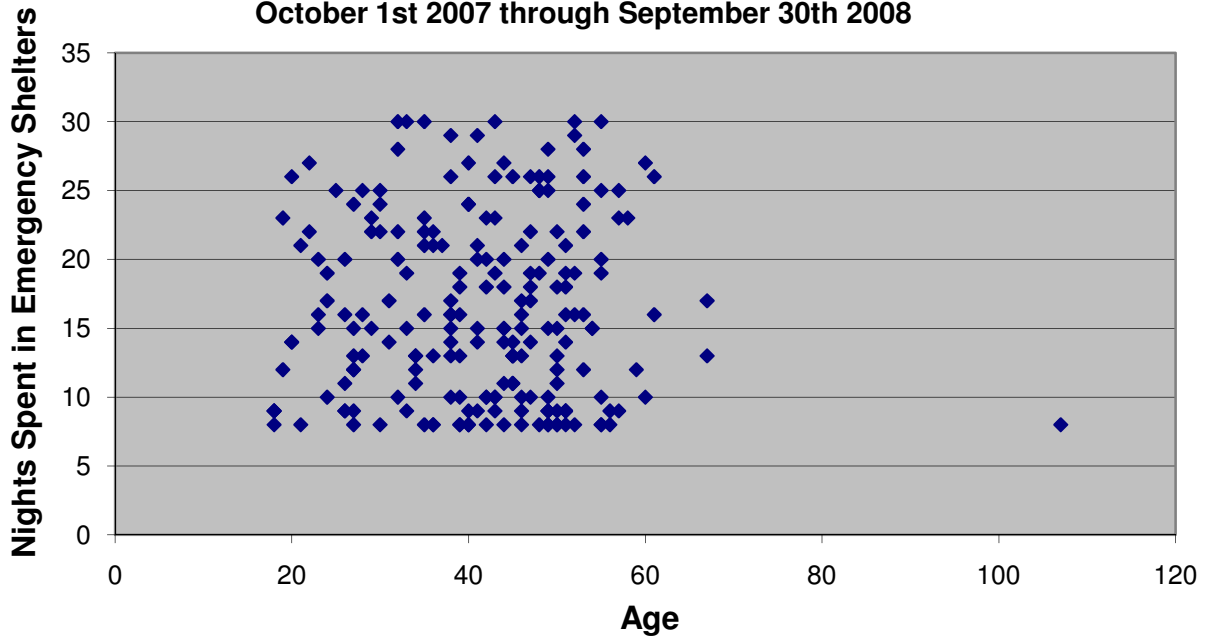
## Total Women who Stayed in Emergency Shelters for 31 to 60 Nights

October 1st 2007 through September 30th 2008



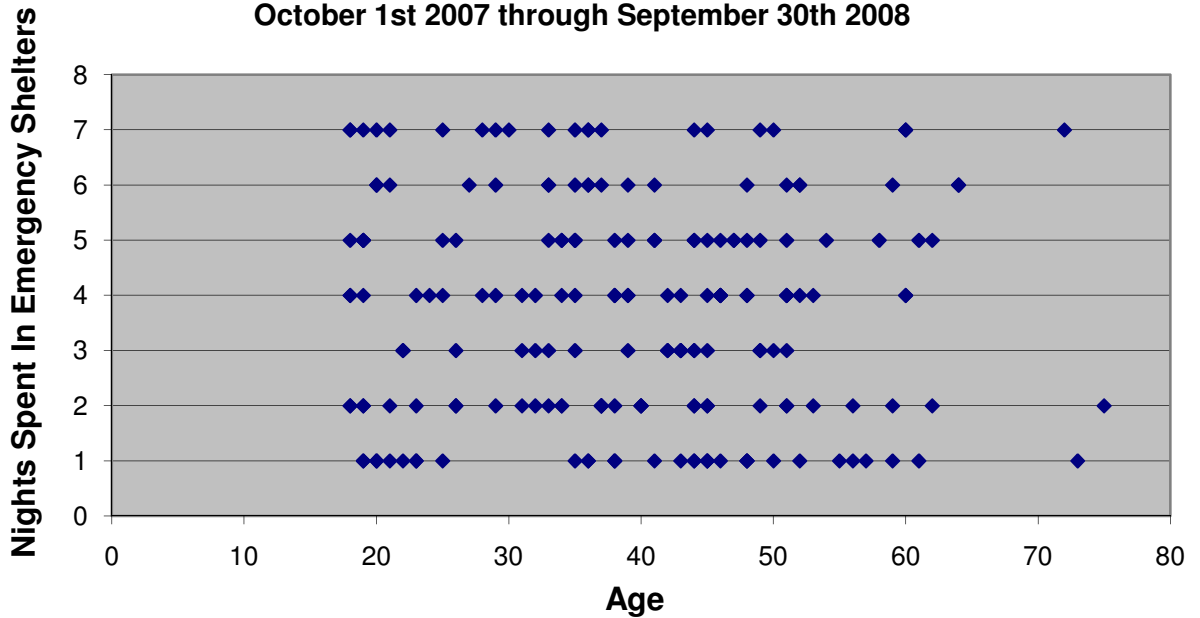
### Total Women who Stayed in Emergency Shelters for 8 to 30 Nights

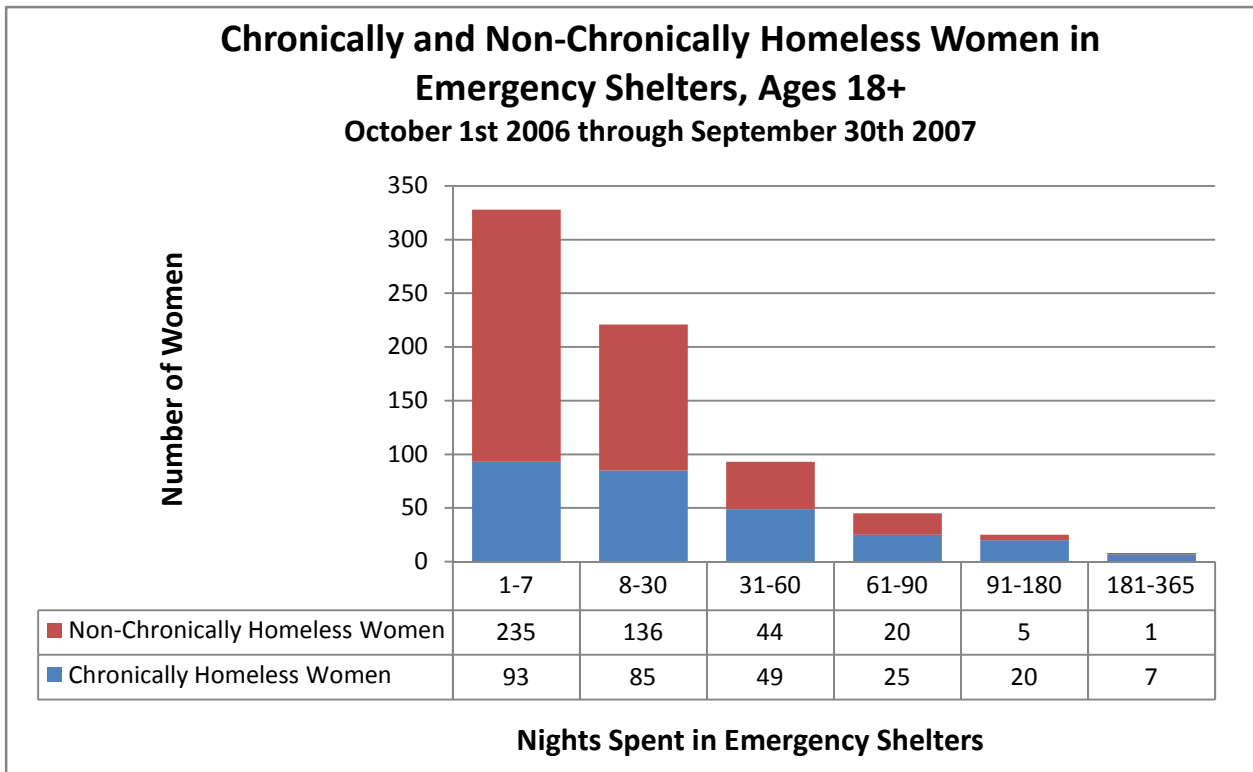
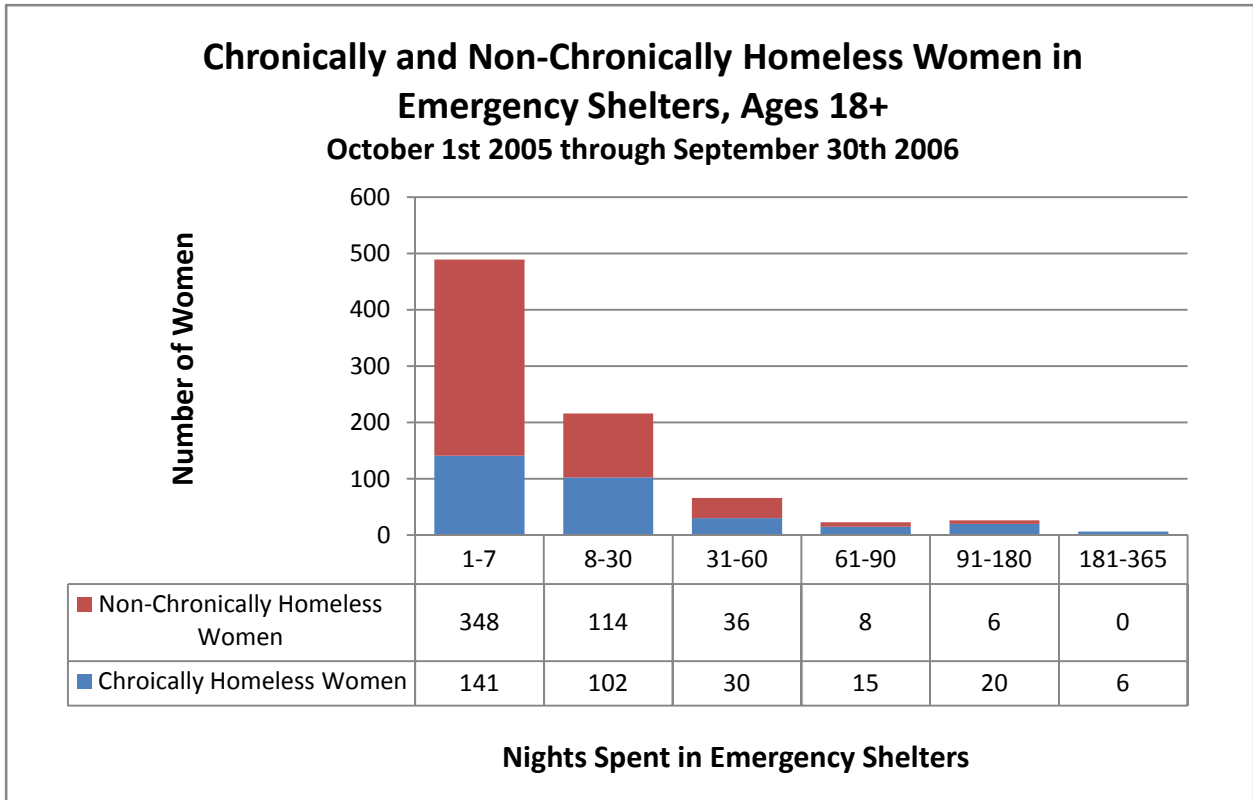


### Total Women who Stayed in Emergency Shelters for 1 to 7 Nights

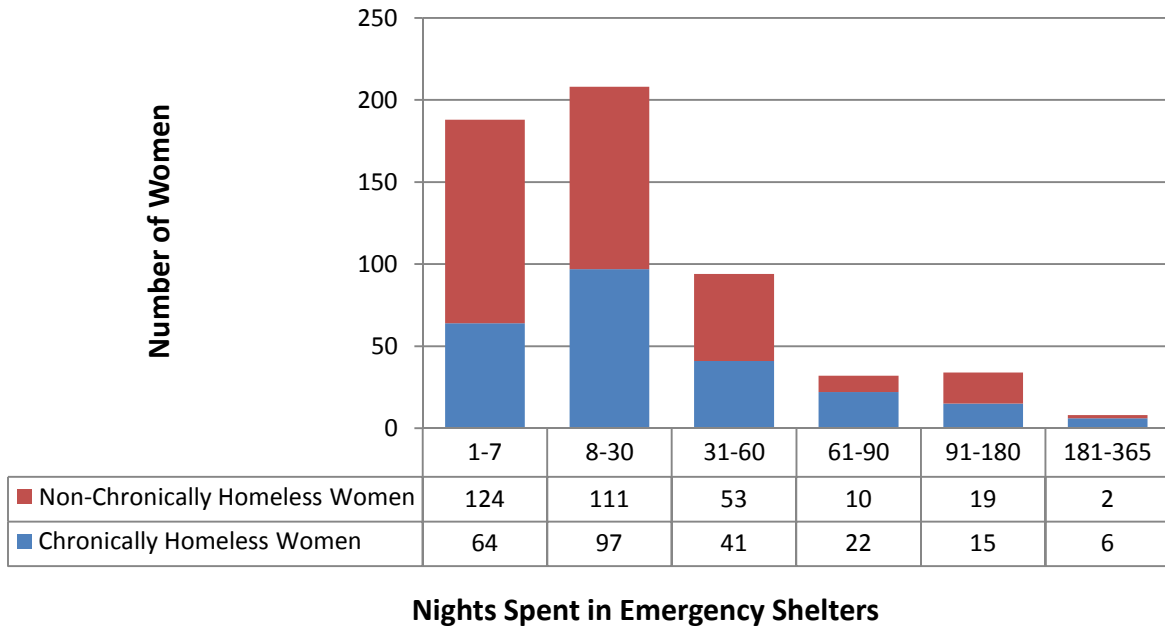

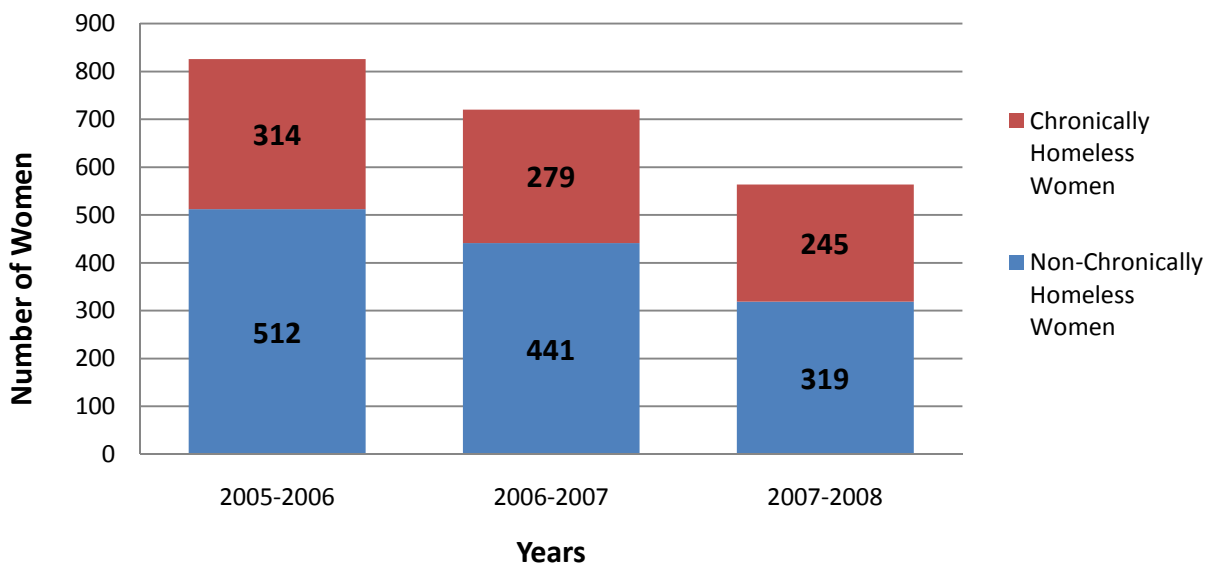
### Chronically and Non-Chronically Homeless Women in Emergency Shelters, Ages 18+

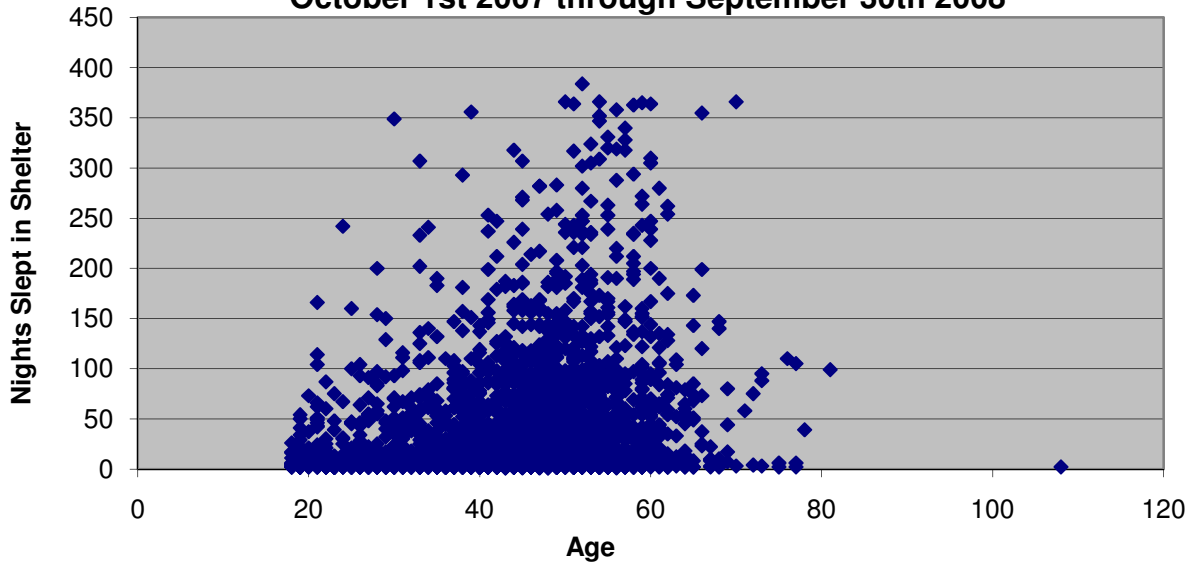

October 1st 2005 through September 30th 2008**

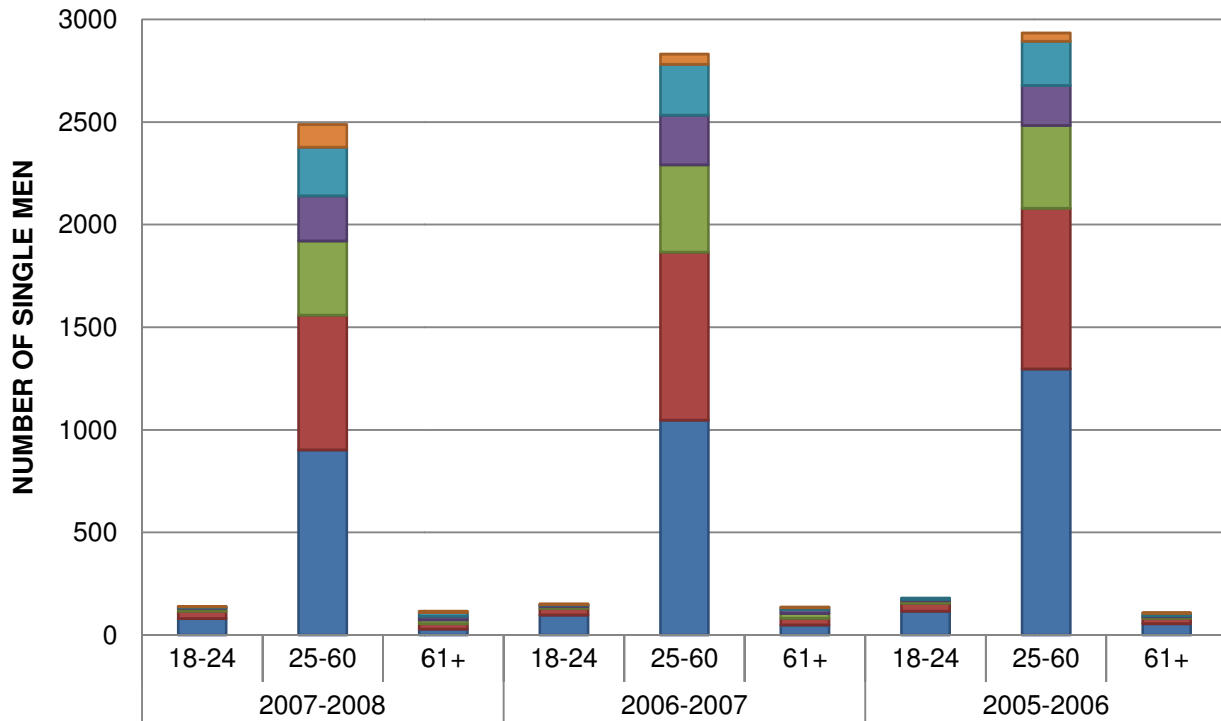


**Nights Spent in Emergency Shelters by Age,

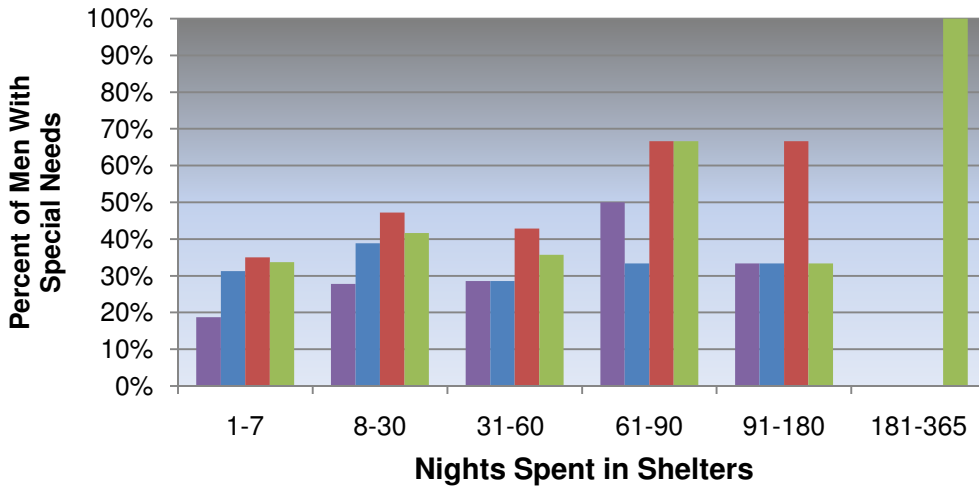

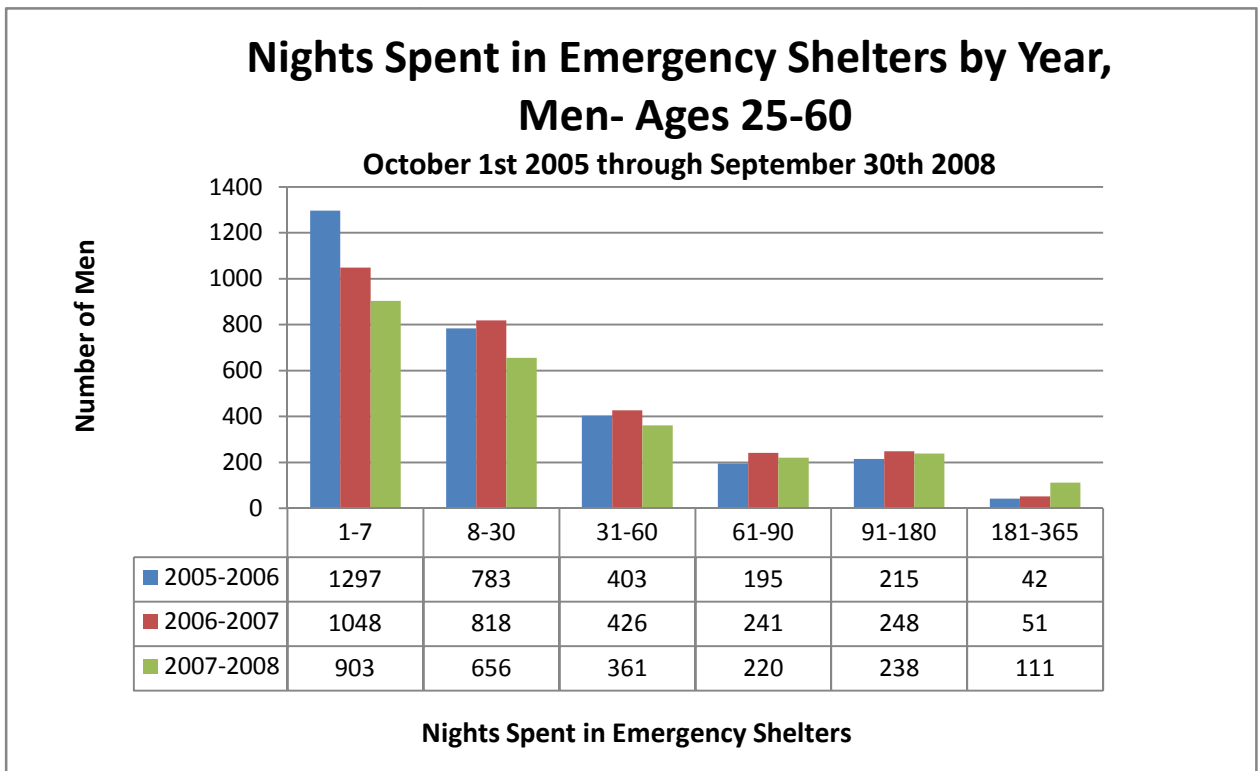
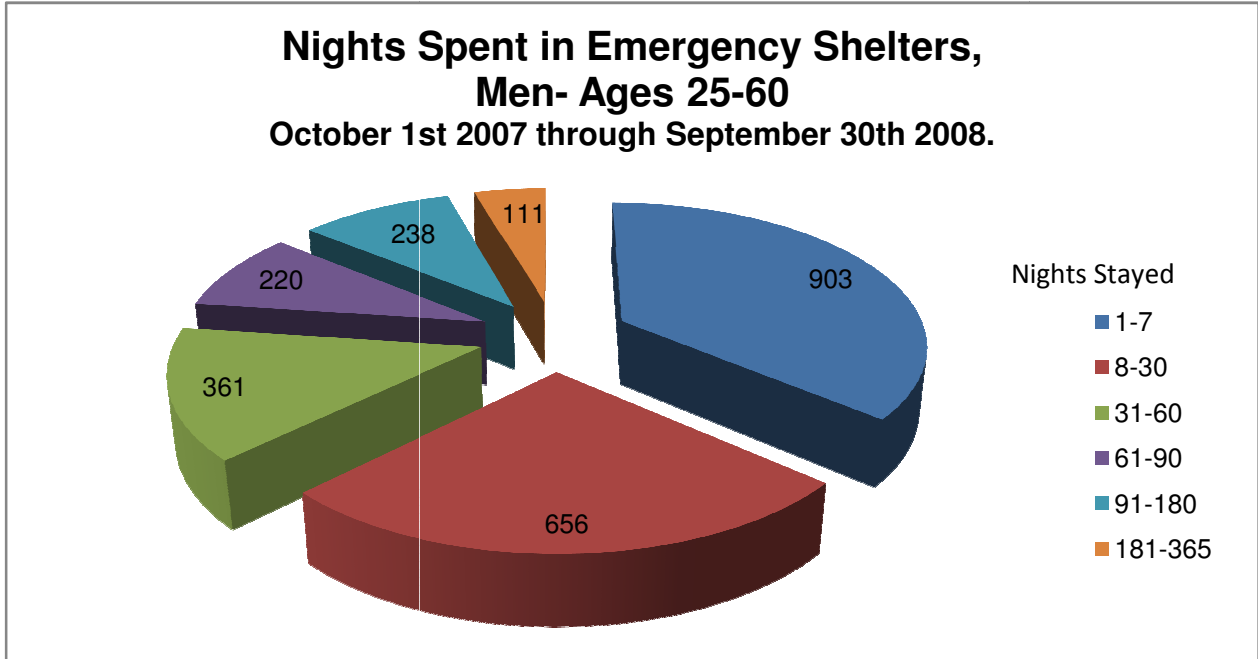
### Percent of Men With Special Needs, Ages 18-24 October 1st 2007 through September 30th 2008.



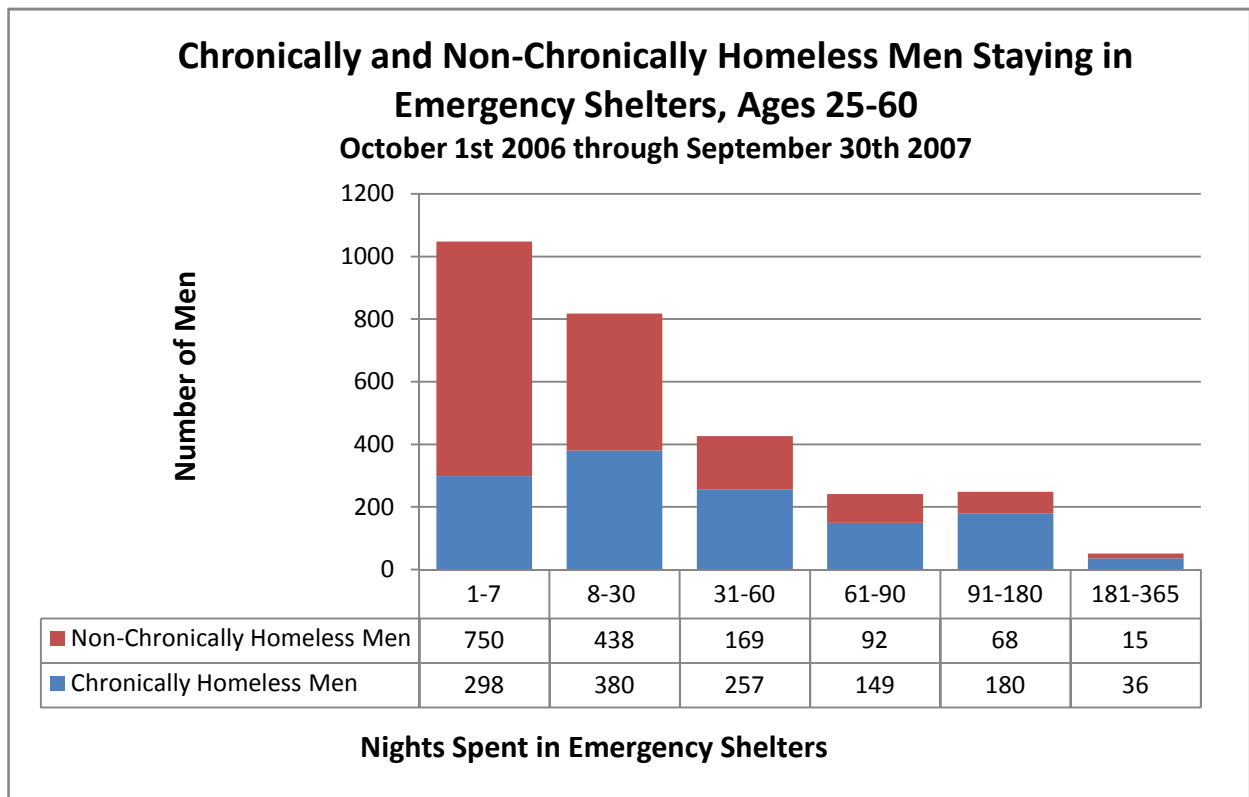
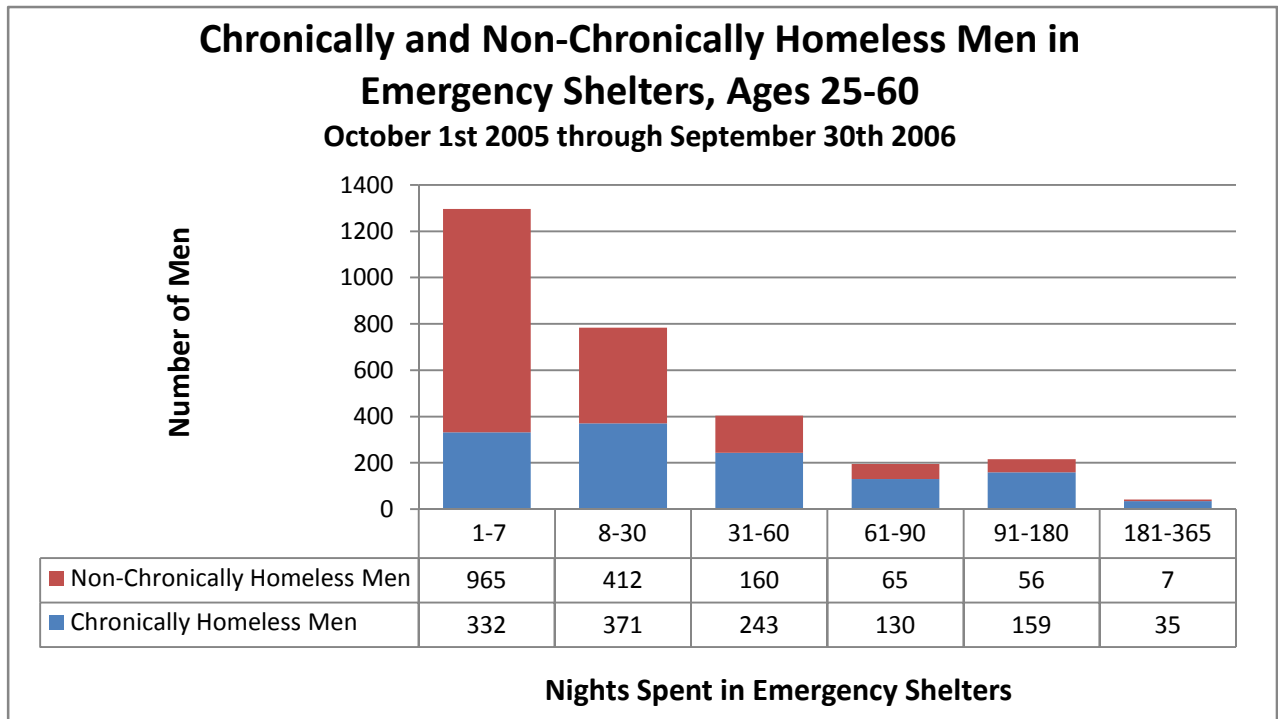

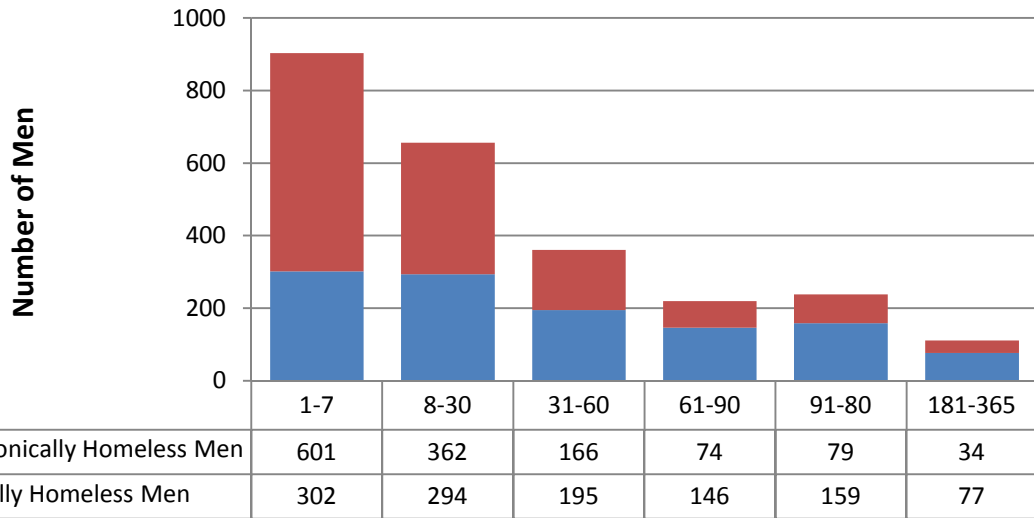

## Chonically and Non-Chronically Homeless Men Staying in Emergency Shelters, Ages 25-60

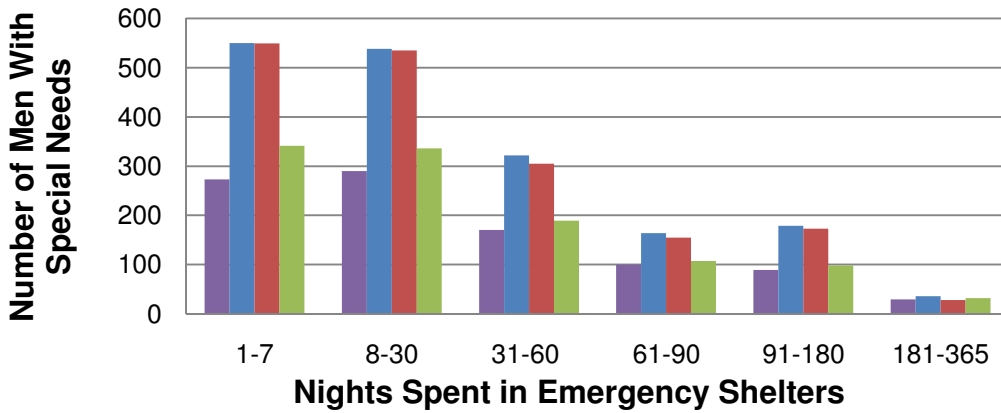

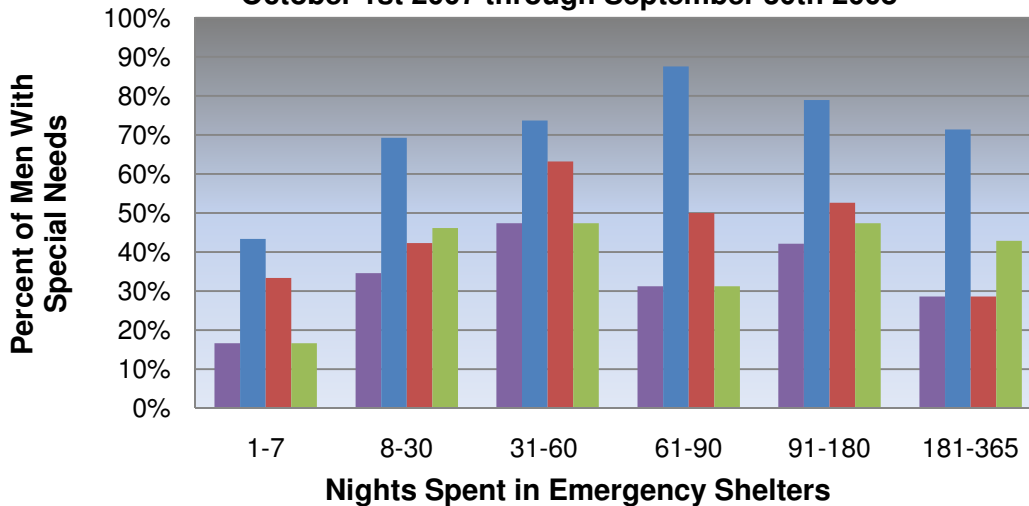

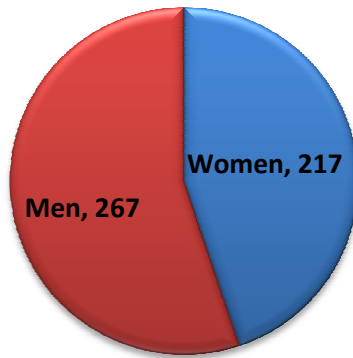

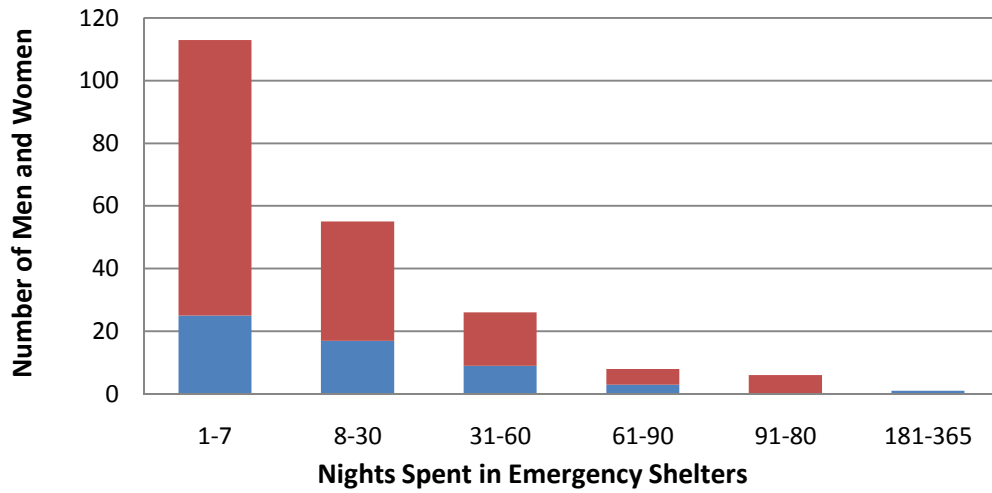
**Nights Men and Women Spent in Emergency Shelters, Ages 18-24**

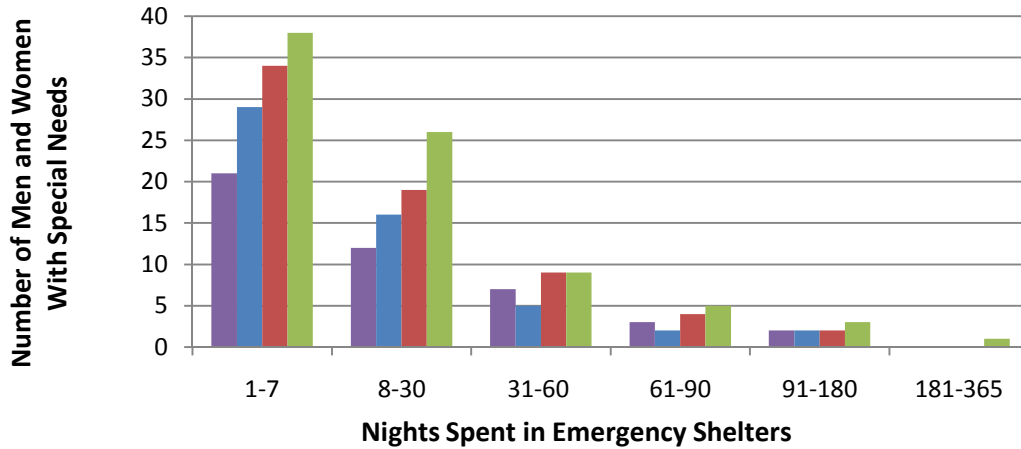

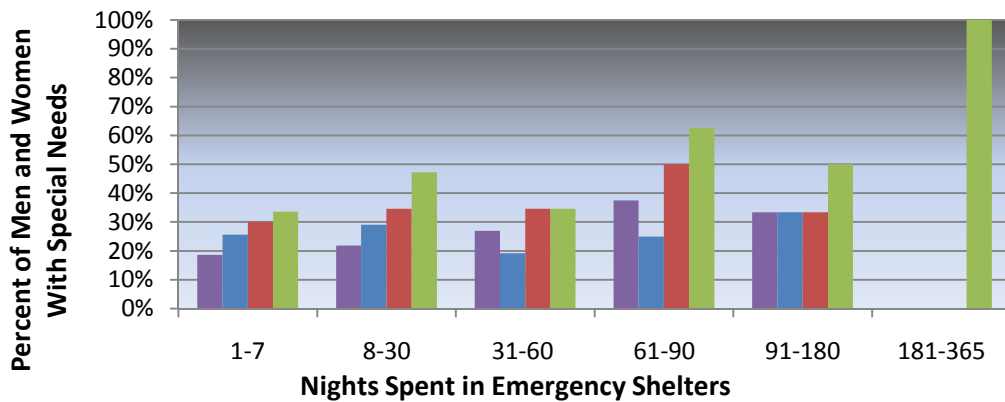
